BRIAN CLAWSON NAMED HEAD VARSITY FOOTBALL COACH AT SHENENDEHOWA

On February 7, 2012, the Shenendehowa Board of Education unanimously approved the recommendation of Brian Clawson as its next football coach. Coach Clawson has an extensive background at both the intercollegiate and high school level. Upon graduating Ithaca College in 1997 where he lettered in football, Brian worked as an assistant coach at Princeton University, Ithaca College and Allegheny College. In 2001, Brian joined the Shenendehowa Central School District as a physical education teacher and football and track coach. Coach Clawson spent seven years at the junior varsity level, including four as the head coach from 2002 through 2007. In 2008, Brian joined the varsity coaching staff and was given the responsibility of working with quarterbacks, wide receivers and linebackers. The past two years, with Coach Clawson as an assistant, Shenendehowa has amassed an 18-4 record and two consecutive trips to the Class AA Section II Super Bowl. The 2011 team defeated Columbia (49-6) to win the Class AA Section II Championship and defeated North Rockland (16-13) to win the New York State Public High School Athletic Association Class AA Regional Championship. In addition to game responsibilities, Brian has been actively involved with helping student-athletes in the recruitment process and helping Shenendehowa players advance and participate at the intercollegiate level. Brian resides in Clifton Park with his wife Stephanie and their three sons, Jason, Jack and Connor.
